Dear Parents,

Before your child begins working in the Summer Bridge Activities workbook, please keep in mind the following:

1. Set up a special time each day for working in the book. After breakfast is ideal. However, when your child is part of the decision making, he/she is more apt to stick with the schedule without resistance.
2. Tear out pages 113-125 as they contain the answers. Keep the answer key in a convenient place for quick reference.
3. Attached is a list of dates and pages to be completed each day to help pace the work over the summer. Keep the list on the refrigerator or glued to the inside of the workbook. Remember, a few pages a day are better for all concerned. Cramming many pages at the end of the summer defeats the purpose of the workbook, because children learn little from this method. Besides keeping up with skills, children may learn the benefits of proper planning.
4. Cut out and use the flashcards in the back of the book for reviewing and memorizing math facts. In September, a timed math test of the basic facts studied during the summer will be given to your child.
5. The Summer Bridge Activities workbook must be completed and returned to your child's teacher on the first day of school.
